WANADA Flu Shot Program Now Open

Registration is now open for WANADA's seasonal flu shot program for dealership employees.

WANADA's flu shot program will be available on-site at WANADA dealerships and administered by Farragut Medical & Travel Care. The on-site service will be available for adults aged 18 and older.

The fee will be \$36 for the vaccine with a minimum of twenty (20) participants required at each location. Locations with less than 20 participants will be billed as if 20 doses of vaccine were administered. The difference will be billed <u>at a rate of \$30 per dose</u>.

As usual, adults 65 and older have a choice of getting the high-dose flu shot, which offers better protection against the flu compared with the regular shot. The fee for the high dose shot will be \$75. Human immune defenses become weaker with age, which places older people at greater risk of severe illness from influenza. In addition, aging decreases the body's ability to have a good immune response after getting influenza vaccine. A higher dose of antigen in the high-dose vaccine gives older people a better immune response against the flu. Data have shown that that leads to greater protection against influenza.

With the popularity of this program, you are encouraged to register early to guarantee the date of your choice. Any request received after August 31 may be subject to vaccine availability.

Farragut Medical will begin conducting on-site visits starting October 1. All scheduling will be done by Farragut Medical upon submission of your registration. Farragut Medical will contact the dealer's designated representative with the scheduled date/time and forward all appropriate forms. Farragut Medical will invoice the dealership directly for all flu shots administered via the program, subject to the 20-dose minimum. From MADA: Temp Tag Update for Titles on Lien Release

Effective immediately, dealers can now issue 60-day temporary tags during the 5-day title hold period pending the release of a lien.

Previously, when a dealer acquired a vehicle, and the lien was in the process of being paid off; a temporary 5-day hold was place on the vehicle record which prevented the issuance of a 60-day temporary tag. We are happy to advise the 5-day hold is no longer in place and you can now issue 60-day temporary tags.

MADA advocated strongly on behalf of the dealers to get the MVA to update their system and address this issue, and we hope this solution will be a benefit to all of our members as well.

From NADA: Enforcement of Transparency in Coverage (TiC) Rules Began on July 1, 2022

In November 2020, the U.S. Departments of Health and Human Services, Labor and the Treasury (Departments) finalized a set of <u>TiC (Transparency in Coverage) Rules</u> requiring that non-grandfathered dealership group health plans and health insurance issuers offering non-grandfathered coverage disclose:

- 1. Negotiated in-network rates for covered items and services;
- 2. Out-of-network allowed amounts and billed charges for covered items and services; and
- 3. Negotiated rates and historical net prices for covered prescription drugs. *This mandate has been delayed pending further rulemaking*.

For plan years beginning on or after January 1, 2022, required TiC disclosures generally must be made on public websites using three separate machine-readable files.

For most dealerships offering group plan insurance coverage, there are no direct TiC compliance obligations as they are the responsibility of their health insurance carriers. Dealerships offering self-insured health plans must link to the machine-readable files listed above on their public facing websites, in a location where login credentials aren't necessary.
