

One of WANADA's most valuable and underutilized member services is also one of the easiest to access: free monthly local automotive market data from two trusted national sources—RL Polk and Auto Outlook.

These data tools are available to all WANADA dealer members at no additional charge and can be instrumental in informing sales strategies, market comparisons, and overall business planning.

Each month, WANADA provides detailed new vehicle registration data for the Washington DC region, sourced from RL Polk, a division of S&P Global Mobility. Polk registration data tracks actual new and used vehicle registrations across the country, offering a highly reliable measure of what's selling, where, and to whom. The data is derived from state Departments of Motor Vehicles and is widely regarded in the industry as a definitive benchmark for understanding market dynamics at a local and national level.



WANADA contracts with Polk to make this critical information available to our dealer members—again, at no extra cost. These reports show new vehicle registrations by make, model, fuel type, and segment, and are an invaluable resource for inventory planning, identifying market trends, and benchmarking dealership performance against regional averages. In addition to Polk's registration numbers, WANADA also partners with Auto Outlook to provide monthly market insight reports, which include detailed commentary and analysis on local sales trends. These reports are based on data from Experian Automotive and go a step beyond raw registration numbers by identifying performance patterns, brand-level gains and losses, market segment shifts, and forecasting likely trends for the months ahead. The January and February 2025 editions of Auto Outlook for the Washington Area are now available:

These monthly reports are especially useful for managers and executives looking for forward-looking guidance or trying to evaluate dealership performance in a broader context.

Taken together, the Polk and Auto Outlook reports offer a powerful combination of hard numbers and strategic insight. Receiving Inventory in your ERT system

MVA issued two bulletins in March about new system functionality about inventory validation. The <u>first bulletin</u> ("Receiving Inventory" dated March 3, 2025) provided dealers and tag and title services with direction regarding the acceptance of plate, sticker, and permit inventory. This inventory clean-up should have been completed by March 17, 2025. The <u>second bulletin</u> ("New Inventory Validation" dated March 27, 2025) provided notice that the inventory validation went live during the evening of April 1, 2025.

Interchangeable Plate Requirements and Procedures

Transfer Plates between Vehicles

Plates can be transferred between vehicles in Class A (passenger), E (trucks) and M (multipurpose) without a customer repurchasing the plates. To transfer a plate between Classes A, E or M, the customer pays the difference between the registration fees associated with the gross vehicle weights (GVW) and the transfer fee of \$15.

Please offer this option to customers at the time of sale for all title transfers.

IRS Reinstates Clean Vehicle Credit Reporting

Buyers of electric vehicles who were unable to claim federal EV tax credits for 2024 now have a remedy, according to an alert from the National Automobile Dealers Association (NADA).

NADA, which "advocated aggressively" for an IRS fix, says the agency has reopened the IRS Energy Credits online portal for dealers to submit time-of-sale reports for EVs sold last year. Only a dealer can sign up for the system, which is available now.

Virginia Motor Vehicle Dealer Board Updates Background Check Procedures

Effective April 1, 2025, MVDB has reduced the number of authorized vendors for background checks. Dealers are responsible for completing the required background checks for initial salesperson licenses. A criminal background check is required before the MVDB 61 can be submitted for the licensing of a new salesperson. You may contact one of the providers listed below to complete your background checks. Be sure to select the complete MVDB background check package. Upon completing the background check the vendor will assign a unique background identifier code specific to the applicant. This identifier code is what you will insert into the MVDB 61 prior to sending the application to the MVDB.

Only the FOUR (4) providers listed below are authorized by the MVDB.

You must move to one of the approved providers no later than April 1, 2025. After April 1, 2025, if the MVDB receives an application with an unapproved background check provider, we will not accept the application, and you will be required to submit an authorized background check.
